To ensure that candidates have the basic skills necessary to administrate Basic Life Support if called on to do so.

THEORY LEVEL: Low

PREREQUISITES: None

AWARD: Certificate

VALIDITY: 2 years

TEST ITEMS

- 1. Answer questions on recognition of respiratory failure, return of spontaneous breathing, and when/how to get help.
- 2. Demonstrate procedures to:-
 - (a) Check responsive and turning victim if necessary.
 - (b) Establish an airway.
 - (c) Administer mouth to mouth and mouth to nose resuscitation and check for signs of breathing.
 - (d) Be able to demonstrate effective skills to administer one operator, cardio-pulmonary resuscitation.
 - (e) Candidates must satisfy the examiner on their recognition of the return of spontaneous breathing.
- 3. Aftercare including recovery position.
