- 4. Administer mouth to mouth and mouth to nose resuscitation.
- 5. Be able to demonstrate effective skills to administer one operator, cardio-pulmonary resuscitation.
- 6. Demonstrate turning of victim from prone to supine.
- 7. Demonstrate effective skills to treat for victim vomiting.
- 8. Aftercare including recovery position.
- 9. Answer questions on any aspect of Basic Life Support theory.
